Practical Examinations

Offered with or without the Knowledge Assessment, the hands on Practical Examination will assess the candidates practical ability. If taken with in one year of the Knowledge Assessment, and both are passed, an NCCER Gold Card Certification will be earned.

Refresher Courses

These courses are intended for operators with experience and are not intended for beginners. Classes are scheduled as needed or by request.

Texas Department of Licensing & Regulation (TDLR)

Industrial Electrician

Electrical Continuing Education
